# Farm Apprenticeships

The South West Peak Landscape Partnership (SWPLP) is supporting farm apprenticeships to encourage young people to take up or stay in farming.

Apprentices can be employed by one or two farmers in the South West Peak. You can work on a relative's farm or we can help find a farm who needs an apprentice.

Apprentices will gain a level 2 Work-based Diploma in Agriculture.

SWPLP will pay for training towards NPTC qualifications e.g. tractor driving, pesticide or chainsaw certificates.

Earn a wage with paid holidays.

Learn about conservation on farms by researching and discussing farming and wildlife issues and working on jobs like farm boundaries and hay meadow restoration with countryside apprentices.
