Take on an Apprentice

The South West Peak Landscape Partnership is supporting farmers in the South West Peak to take on an apprentice.

Farmers can employ a family member and will need to pay apprentices the minimum wage (from £3.70 per hour)

We will fund additional training for the apprentice (e.g. tractor, ATV, pesticides or chainsaw licenses)

Farmers will need to allow the apprentice an average of one day a week to complete training but can also access a team of up to 6 people for help with work on boundaries, woodlands, rights of way or other practical tasks.
