Countryside Worker Apprenticeships

The South West Peak Landscape Partnership is employing Countryside Worker apprentices in the South West Peak.

You will be employed by the Peak District National Park Authority on behalf of the Partnership.

Apprentices will gain a level 2 Work-based Diploma in Environmental Conservation and have the opportunity to gain NPTC qualifications e.g. chainsaw, brush-cutter or pesticide certificates.

You will earn a wage with paid holidays.

You will spend most of your time working in the South West Peak with the Peak District National Park Authority and our partners including: Cheshire Wildlife Trust, Staffordshire Wildlife Trust, RSPB and others.

You will also learn about conservation on farms by working on jobs like repairing farm boundaries and hay meadow restoration with agriculture apprentices.
